These alarms have a unique system that does away with false indications from wind, weed and twigs. When they sound, you'll know there's a carp on the line.



FALSE ALARMS ARE A THING OF THE PAST

HAVING spent the past couple of weekends attending packed angling shows, and seeing the crowds flocking around the Nash stand, there is no doubt in my mind that the latest Nash Siren R3 bite alarm system will sell like crazy.

The alarms themselves have integral rubberised snag ears and feature 'Intelligent Sensing' microchip technology to eliminate false indications while giving you an insight into what's actually

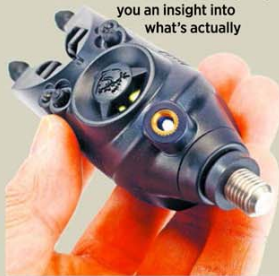
happening in your swim. To keep the technical jargon to a minimum, this sensing system is based around changes of speed in the movement of the line. You'll suffer no more irritating bleeps from wind, undertow, weed and variable currents when fishing in running water or lakes with a heavy tow.

Best of all, there won't be any nagging doubts over those unexplained single bleeps that have dogged all carp anglers ever since electronic bite alarms came on the scene.

The R3 has an extreme working range of more than 400m.

While I would never encourage anyone to leave their rods unattended, or indeed be anywhere near that distance away from them, the strength of the radio signal can be critical when the rods are not in a clear line of sight, or are surrounded by dense foliage.

RECEIVING YOU LOUD AND CLEAR

THE Nash R3 Receiver precisely replicates the R3 alarm's Intelligent Sensing - as well as offering bleep-for-bleep tone reproduction even in difficult swims or around obstacles.

It works at distances of 400m or more from the rods, so you can be sure the radio signal between your alarms and the remote won't be compromised.

There's a four-channel, one-touch pairing with the R3 alarm heads plus a clever additional fifth channel to programme in your mate's alarms, which is very handy if you always fish together.

As you'd expect, there are adjustable volume, vibration and mute functions, and a four-colour lens option pack allows the receiver to be customised to match any LED on the alarm heads.

The receiver is powered by one CR123A 3V battery.

An anti-theft warning alarm, a useful feature in these wicked times, tops off an impressively high list of specifications.

The high-impact soft touch case has waterproof gasket seals.

It looks quite different to any other box you'll see on the bank, but the distinctive frame and four-leg configuration combine to produce a rock-solid and frighteningly strong parking space for your bum

that will survive years of being lugged about in sheds, garages and the backs of vans.

Made from ultra-light aircraft grade aluminium, the box features a European-patented four-leg system that remains stable even when you

stand up. This is all down to a no-nonsense design and top grade materials, coupled with quality Continental engineering.

Now available in four colours - Maver green, mango, orange, black or white - this is a box that will get you noticed. Without the middle set of legs that you'd find on a conventional box, you're left with room to swing your legs around

SIDE TRAY
The Z Frame comes complete with a good sized lightweight but robust Maver side tray which is easily fitted on to either side of the box.

SIDE ATTACHMENT UPRIGHT
As the frame design only utilises four legs, side attachment uprights are provided on either side of the seatbox. These are height-adjustable and fully compatible with all standard box fittings.

FOOTPLATE HANDWHEEL
The sturdy slide in-out footplate is held firmly in position when being used or transported by an easy to find and operate handwheel.

MUDFEET
The four mudfeet on the S4 Z Frame seatbox have a wide splay to spread the weight of the angler, and each one is independently adjustable. Once you think the box is level, you can double-check using the built-in spirit levels.

BUMP BAR
The S4 Z Frame comes with this unique bump bar which has a central fitting area, helping to keep the pole still in the worst of winds. The configuration of set-up allows it to be used from both the left and right-hand sides.

Levelling is achieved via handwheels that lock into place with non-slip compression blocks.

Built-in spirit levels will let you know once the box is dead level.

The Z Frame is also equipped with unobtrusive half-legs for attaching trays and arms, plus a sliding non-slip cassette footplate, 30mm

round legs, pivoting locking mudfeet and a pole-style gel seat.

Beneath this is a winder tray, and that brings us nicely to one of the main considerations when buying a seatbox - storage space.

Three set-ups are on offer with the Z Frame - a twin front and single cross drawer, double cross drawer or twin front drawer and double winder tray. You can add to this from the

massive range of separate S4 trays.

To finish, a sliding module sat on runners beneath the main top unit has a single 50mm tray, to which more can be added.

The Z Frame comes complete with an accessory pack worth more than £150, including a pole spraybar, side tray, umbrella arm and short keepnet arm.
